

STEP SIX

Adjust Headset Setting



Make sure that the Microphone Mute button is not red and that the Volume control is in a middle setting.

Click on the different tabs to explore different settings that will help you get the most out of your Plantronics PerSono headset.

Headphone Tab

This tab lets you adjust settings for the headset speakers. For example, you can select preset equalization levels for different styles of music to which you may want to listen.

Microphone Tab

This tab lets you adjust settings for the microphone. For example, you can test the microphone output level and select preset equalization levels for different speech applications.

Audio Tab

This tab lets you open audio applications that you have installed on your system such as MP3 and CD players.

Talk Tab

This tab lets you open talk applications that you have installed on your system such as chat, internet phone, and voice recognition programs.

STEP SEVEN

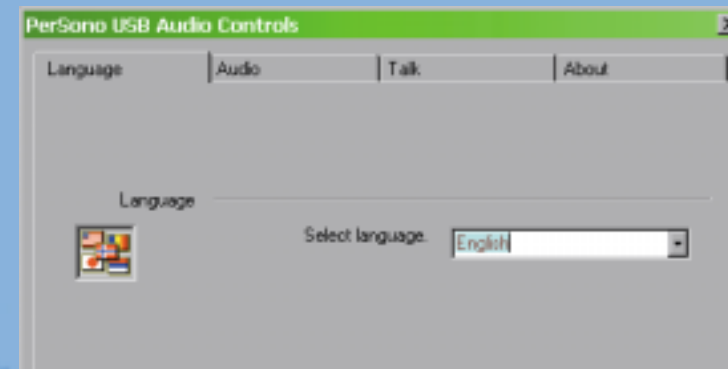
Choose Your Language/PerSono Defaults

Click on the PerSono Control Panel icon (in the upper left-hand corner of the PerSono interface) to open the PerSono Control Panel. Click on the *Content* tab and select your language from the pull-down menu. Click *OK*.

Click the Help icon on the PerSono for instructions on assigning defaults for Talk and Audio tabs.

STEP EIGHT

GETTING STARTED

Windows 98, 98SE users: You must have your Windows installation CD ready. Some computer manufacturers copy the Windows installation files onto the computer's hard disk.

STEP ONE

Install and Register Your Software

1. Insert the Plantronics PerSono CD into your computer. If the introduction program does not start automatically soon after you insert the CD in your computer, do the following:

Windows

- On the Windows desktop, double-click the My Computer icon.
- Double-click the Plantronics PerSono CD.
- Double-click the Setup.exe file.

Note: Windows 2000 users need to have Administrator level Security Privileges to install the Headset and the PerSono software on their computer.

Macintosh

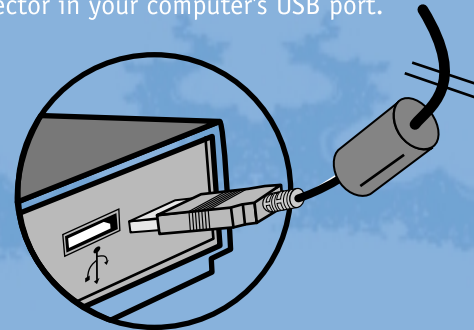
- Double-click the PerSono CD icon.
 - Double-click the readme.txt icon.
 - Double-click the PerSono Intro icon.
2. Click Continue to advance to the PerSono Audio Control Center Software Installation page.
 3. **Windows:** Click the PerSono Install button to launch the install program.
Macintosh: Double-click the PerSono Installer icon.

The introduction program will allow you to register your PerSono software online. Please take a moment to fill out the form and register.

STEP TWO

Headset Installation

When prompted by the installation program, insert the headset's USB connector in your computer's USB port.



Note: To use a USB hub with the Plantronics DSP Series headset, the hub must have its own power supply.

Windows 98 and 98SE users must insert their Windows installation CD unless a copy of the installation files exists on the hard disk. The Add New Hardware Wizard will find and install up to five different drivers using several different installation dialogs.

When prompted for drivers, choose *Search for the best driver* and select the *CD-ROM drive* checkbox as the driver location. If prompted to restart the system, wait until you have finished the installation program completely before restarting. Refer to the Windows Installation Guide for detailed instructions.

STEP THREE

Install Bonus Software from the Plantronics PerSono CD

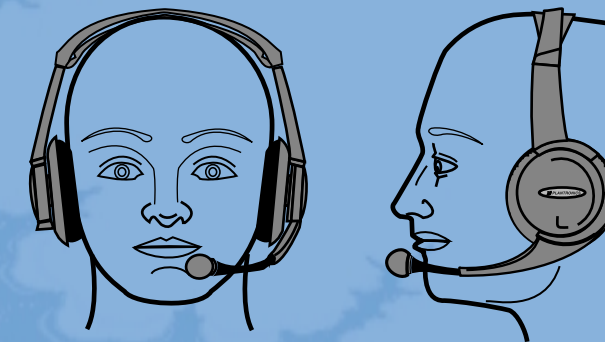
We've included several applications that will help you get the most out of your Plantronics DSP Series headset. The bonus software installation is optional. Applications are installed one at a time. Click the button with the name of the application you wish to install. When installation is complete, you will be returned to the Bonus Software Installation page. You may then choose to install more applications. When installation(s) are complete, click *Quit*.

Note: You do not need to install the bonus software to use your DSP Series headset. If you choose not to install these programs now, click *Done*. To install at a later date, skip the PerSono Software installation program and advance to the Bonus Software Installation page.

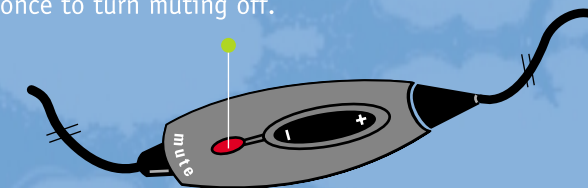
STEP FOUR

Put on the headset and set the microphone position.

Adjust the microphone so that it is 1cm (about 1/2") from the center of your mouth both horizontally and vertically. If you can hear yourself breathe through the microphone, move it horizontally closer to the side of your mouth.



Make sure that the microphone mute switch is off—if it is red, click it once to turn muting off.



STEP FIVE

Launch PerSono Audio Control Center

Double click the Plantronics PerSono Audio Control Center Software icon in the system tray to open the Plantronics PerSono application. You can also open the application by opening the shortcut on the Desktop or Program Files/PerSono/PerSono.exe.



Double click system tray icon to open the Plantronics PerSono Audio Control Center.
